
It is heartening to note that all the Vidyalayas are following the activities chalked out under the programme in spite of the pandemic and the resultant set back.



One of the main attractions of this festival is the masked dancers of Himachal Pradesh known as Mandeyalas. These masks differ from village to village and according to the sculpton's taste. These masks covery a powerful and mysterious emotion of its sculpton.
